

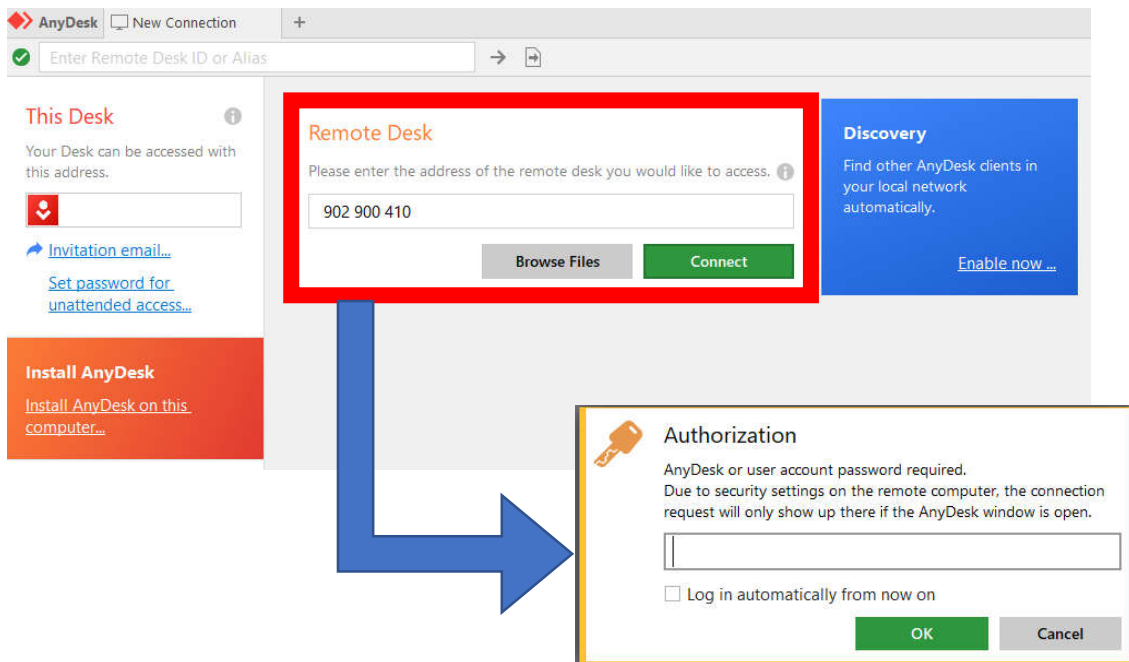
Accessing MicFac workstations remotely

First, download the Anydesk software from www.anydesk.com. It is available for Mac and PC.



Run Anydesk (it doesn't have to be installed).

Input the ID of the workstation you wish to access under "remote desk" and click Connect. A table with each workstation IDs is on the next page.



Then input the Anydesk workstation password:

micfacworkstation

You will now have access to the machine and can use it normally. You may need to log onto the "micfacuser" account if the previous user logged off in Windows.

We highly recommend only remoting into the workstations while on-campus, ideally through a wired (Ethernet) connection. You may experience slowdowns, poor graphics performance, or other issues if your connection is not fast or reliable enough.

When you are ready to use a workstation, **MAKE A RESERVATION FIRST!**
If your reservation is over, **END YOUR SESSION!**

Other users cannot access the workstation if you leave the connection open. If you have a reservation and someone else has the system locked, call us and we will disconnect them.
